- Hangtime, **Pinot Noir**, California 9 32
vivid red fruit with strawberry flavors, hints of spice, a lithe texture, and well-balanced acidity on the palate.
- Roth, **Pinot Noir**,
Sonoma Coast, California *bottle only 65
This graceful style features ripe plum, strawberry and blueberry notes, ending clean and snappy, with firm tannins.
- Hahn, **Pinot Noir**, "SLH",
Santa Lucia Highlands, California 13 40
Soft tannins, delicious plum and cherry aromas and flavors, a hint of allspice and an underpinning of the earth itself with an irresistibly silky, velvety texture.

Medium Intensity

Listed from milder to stronger

- Row by Row, **Merlot**, California 7 28
Deep ruby hues with fruit-forward aromas of black cherries and rich deep flavors of freshly picked plums and light toasty oak
- Rodney Strong, **Merlot**,
Sonoma County, California 10 40
Plum and blueberry flavors with a touch of dried herb and a toasty, spicy vanilla character, and a lingering berry-cream finish.
- Hahn, **Cabernet Sauvignon**, "
Nicky Hahn", California 8 30
Wonderful structure with cedar notes and raspberry on the nose; silky tannins in the mouth.
- Eos Estate Winery, **Zinfandel**,
Paso Robles, California 9 36
Fresh red fruit in the front with a medium body and a touch of spice on the finish
- Liberty School, **Cabernet Sauvignon**,
Paso Robles, California 10 40
Opens with aromas of black cherry, plum and violets, followed by subtle flavors of strawberry and allspice. Firm yet supple tannins.
- Dreyer Sonoma, **Cabernet Sauvignon**,
Sonoma County, California *bottle only 38
full bodied with black fruit & hints of oak & tobacco
- Guenoc, **Cabernet Sauvignon**,
Lake County, California 7 28
Smooth, bright and juicy with fresh plum, raspberry and juicy acidity with good balance.

Medium Intensity Red Wines

Listed from milder to stronger

- Crios de Susana Balbo, **Malbec**,
Mendoza, Argentina 10 36
exhibits a fragrant bouquet of cherry and wild strawberries leading to a medium-bodied, dry, concentrated wine with lots of spicy red fruits and excellent balance.
- Zaca Mesa, "Z Cuvée",
Santa Ynez Valley, California *bottle only 65
A zesty red, with lively notes of floral raspberry, smoky fresh herbs and pepper. Grenache, Mourvèdre and Cinsault.
- Michel Picard, Côtes du Rhône,
Rhône, France 7 28
Soft and easy, with plum, tobacco and lavender notes.
- Piccini, Chianti Classico,
Tuscany, Italy 9 36
A leafy, savory style, with light hints of cherry and flavors of leather, tobacco and underbrush.
- Adelante, **Malbec**, Mendoza, Argentina 9 30
Intense aromas of blackberry, plum and mocha
- Southern Belle, **Red**,
Murcia, Spain *bottle only 40
Aged in world renowned pappy van winkle bourbon barrels. Full-bodied and supple with the bourbon notes sharing the stage with the ripe red fruit, toffee and vanilla
- Austin Hope, **Red Blend**, "Troublemaker",
Central Coast, California 11 44
A racy Rhône blend, with appealing smoke, leather and blackberry aromas, presenting zesty dried cherry, herbal, licorice and tar flavors that firm up on the tannic finish. Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre, Petite Sirah and Zinfandel.
- TriVento, "Amado Sur",
Mendoza, Argentina 10 40
This ripe red delivers jammy cherry, boysenberry and spice notes, backed by fresh acidity, light tannins and a zesty finish of spice box, licorice and smoke. Malbec, Bonarda and Syrah.
